# Minutes of the May 18th, 2023 Online Harvard Cable Access Committee Meeting Approved June 8th, 2023

**Meeting Minutes:** Minutes of the April 27th meeting were reviewed and unanimously approved.

### **Budget and Finance:**

 According to Nick, labor expenses continue to fall, and the gap between the projected budget and the actual budget is close to \$11,000, so money for new hardware/software looks promising.

### **Charter License Fee:**

- Because Charter has not been responsive with regards to a contract renewal, Bill Solomon believes the town should raise the fee to 4.85% now rather than in January of 2025. The current contract allows us to make this change, and we should take advantage of it. Robert made a motion that we recommend to the Select Board that we raise the license fee to 4.85% effective January 17th, 2024. The motion passed unanimously.
- Robert asked about Cablevision subscription numbers. In 2014, 1,439 households subscribed to Cablevision compared to the present number of 1,014. That represents a 30% reduction in subscribers.

### **Charter Contract Renewal:**

- Brittany suggested that if a new contract doesn't get signed, then the old contract would continue. Both the towns of Boylston and Douglas do not have newly signed contracts.
- The Ascertainment Report has been drafted.

### **Capital Expenditures**:

• Before FY23 ends, Brittany would like to purchase a new Macbook Pro laptop for \$4,800, a Blackmagic Pocket Cinema Camera for \$2,535, and a Zoom lens for the aforementioned camera for \$1,300. Nick made a motion to approve a capital expenditure not to exceed \$9,000 for a new laptop, camera, and lens. The motion passed unanimously.

### **Station Manager's Report:**

- Brittany informed the committee that because the Bromfield Middle School will be moving to a separate and different schedule from the high school, Cindy Fontaine will not be able to teach the Middle School Video Production class, and hence, the class will not run. Brittany will reach out to Principal Greene to see what can be done about the situation.
- Nick asked how the Media Production Club was doing. At present, the attendance numbers are way down, but Brittany plans on heavy advertising in the fall.
- The idea of a weeklong summer video production course at FiveSparks was floated, and the committee thought that idea had nice potential.
- Patrick wondered if the creation of a trailer video for either the video production course or the media club would help draw interest.
