Joshua Bath, contractor for Kemeza family who own the property at 101 Shaker Road, Harvard, presented an application for repair and renovations to include chimney reconstruction, adding a dryer vent and a bathroom vent/stack. Bath described the proposed project as follows:

The rear chimney of the main structure (one of two) would be taken down below the roof line and rebuilt in the same style using similar bricks (existing bricks cannot be reused)

A bathroom vent/stack would be added to the roof of the structure and would be painted black to reduce visual impact

A dryer vent may be added to the side of the structure near an existing dyer vent and would be painted to match the color of the structure – alternatively it may be moved to the rear of the house (not visible from street)

It was unanimously voted to treat this as an insubstantial change and Bath was asked to inform the HHC when the owners will be ready to produce sample bricks and final plans so that the change can be considered at a future meeting.
