Nashoba Associated Boards of Health 2024 Pet Rabies Clinics- Full Schedule

In conjunction with our member Boards of Health, the Nashoba Associated Boards of Health have scheduled rabies vaccination clinics throughout the District to provide an opportunity for residents to have their dogs and cats vaccinated. We are grateful for the support we receive from the participating veterinarians to provide this valuable and important service.

ALL DOGS AND CATS MUST BE IMMUNIZED AGAINST RABIES

Rabies immunization for dogs and cats over six (6) months of age, not previously immunized, and those with a blue rosette (2021) rabies tag must be immunized. The tag for 2024 will be a **red heart**. Depending on the vaccination status of your dog or cat the veterinarian will inform you of the expiration date for the rabies vaccine given to your pet at this visit.

Please bring a copy of your pet's last rabies certificate if you have it.

Residents of Nashoba towns may attend any of the following clinics.

Cats must be brought in cages or closed boxes during the last half of any clinic.
