- 2. There was a discussion concerning the request from the Selectmen for an opinion on additional sewer system capacity available for a possible development at Hildreth. Commissioners believe there is additional capacity, after serving district properties, of 3000 gallons per day and concluded that it is premature to commit that capacity to a project.

On a motion made and seconded, the Commissioners voted to approve and send the attached letter to Ron Ricci, Chair of Board of Selectmen.

3. There was discussion about properties that could connect to the system without expansion. Ms. Russo agreed to contact the residents of 25 Oak Hill Road, who had expressed an interest in connection.
