#### **Budget and Finance**:

- Nick reported that not much had changed with regards to the FY22 budget and projections.
- Nick assembled some answers to the town's questions concerning the FY23 projected budget and will submit those answers tomorrow, 1/13/23. Any feedback from committee members prior to submission is welcome.

#### **TV Production Class:**

- Brittany reported that as of right now only six students are signed up for the video production class which is low compared to prior years. Cindy Fontaine spoke to middle school principal Stephen Green about running a future 8th grade elective, and Green was receptive to the idea. Regardless, Brittany is a little concerned about the low numbers.
- Robert suggested making the course description more exciting and adding a unit on YouTube/influencer video production that might really interest students.
- Nick and Robert suggested connecting the class with The Harvard Press to create news videos. Robert will speak with John Osborne in the next couple of weeks about it.

#### **Station Manager's Report:**

- The station is forging ahead with Vimeo closed captioning. There is not a significant delay in adding the closed captioning.
- Because Assabet co-op students must be paid minimum wage, and the town will not do that, the station cannot employ these students which Brittany finds particularly frustrating

as we could use their help. Nick has discussed this problem with Marie Sobalvarro, and he may address the Personnel Board to see if this policy can be changed.

#### New Business:

- Nick will be leaving the committee in June, and his position as chair will need to be filled.
- On Wednesday, January 25th, a public hearing will take place for the renewal of the Charter contract. Nick is putting together a Public Information Sheet and welcomes input from the committee. The Public Information Sheet will go out to the town shortly.
- Bob O'Shea needs a home space for the new Parks and Recreation director and asked Nick if the station would be willing to house the individual. Brittany said there was not much in the way of space, perhaps a corner, and Robert, Chris, and Dave all thought that placing Parks and Rec in the HCTV station simply didn't make much sense, especially since there wasn't a separate, private office the new director could use.

The meeting adjourned at 7:00 PM.
