The Commission briefly discussed how to proceed with this violation, which resulted in Jim Burns making a motion to issue an Enforcement Order requiring activity cease and desist, the installation of the siltation barrier and the filing of a Notice of Intent with the Conservation Commission for said activity. Paul Willard seconded the motion. The vote was unanimously in favor of the motion.

Jim Burns made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:44pm. Paul Willard seconded the motion. The vote was unanimously in favor of the motion.
