#### Memorial Bench Policy

Mark – took inventory – 22 benches, most are granite or recycled wood, only benches at track and adjoining trail are in disrepair

Michelle – on having a bench plan – "get something done for what we need to get done"

# **Current Financial Status (24:56)**

Doug reviewed budget – have spent 6% of beach and 4% of commons budget, irrigation repairs submitted but not yet paid

DPW lime and fertilizer bills have not come in, Keith had not heard of DPW status on purchase Michelle to start beach purchasing in January

Bob sent Catherine email to move internet charges from commons to beach

Doug mentioned BHRA funds submitted on 9/3 but have not hit Munis

Bob mentioned 10K of commons revolving is movie money

Mark says beach mulch this year was extra, we will need to pay next year as we will be only user Discussion about ballfield maintenance – hard to communicate with baseball coaches / booster club

Keith presented spreadsheet; DPW not signed on to do infield maintenance

Bob – 40K for basic expenses, given 25,650

Track has \$500 on sprreasheet

Mark spoke with Tim K about track, he will repair large cracks, will not do spider cracks

Harvard Park annual maintenance should be separate section on spreadsheet

## o Draft Budget

Beach had almost double parking sticker sales – 483 last year, 652 this year

Stickers don't tell numbers as many parked in school lot

New programs discussed; extend hours – for income and liability reasons

Minimum of 3 guards at all times, beach director as one of the guards

Doug – set expectations with beach director

Bob will update spreadsheet (will need to increase fees if number is greater than 68) **ACTION**Michelle – proposing classes all day long in a smaller area, leaving beach open to morning patrons

Bob – gate keeper and 3 guards should be paid for by town budget

BHRA met on 9/28 and are still reviewing contract

Tree maintenance needed to trail behind Harvard Park – Mark to investigate Northeast corner of field – irrigation pipe uncovered
