

TOWN CAUCUS

The Town Caucus is held to nominate candidates for election to certain town offices. A registered voter in Harvard may be nominated for an open seat by another registered voter in Harvard. The nomination must be seconded by another registered voter in Harvard. The two people receiving the highest number of votes for each opening will be nominated by the caucus.

You need not be present at the caucus to be nominated for a position, however you must sign the Caucus Certificate of Nomination within 72 hours in the Town Clerk's office for your name to appear on the ballot.
