

## Annual Stickers

Stickers can be purchased at:

- Town Hall during regular business hours beginning June 2019.
- Mail in forms. Print from Transfer Station website, mail to Town hall with payment and a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- Note that online purchases have a 50¢ processing fee. Stickers will be mailed within 5-7 business days.

\*\*\*Stickers must be affixed to lower driver side (left) corner of your windshield. \*\*\*

## Basic Recycling

If not sure ASK staff.

- Glass (Bottles and Jars only)
  - Tin and Aluminum Cans
  - Plastic bottles, jars, jugs & tubs
  - Clean paper, newspaper, mixed paper and flattened cardboard boxes
- No Styrofoam & No plastic bags

## Town of Harvard SMART Program (Save Money And Reduce Trash)

Take your Harvard green trash bags to the Transfer Station on Wednesday and Saturday for disposal.

Purchase bags:

- Harvard General Store
- Harvard Outdoor Power Equipment
- Westward Orchards
- Ayer Shop 'n Save
- Bolton Orchards
- Moore's Hardware in Ayer

Seniors will get free bags with purchase of sticker, June 2019 only (at Town Hall)

Cost:

- Annual Fee/Sticker \$80

Harvard green bag fees cover disposal cost:

- 15 gallon, \$1 each, sold in rolls of 5= \$5
- 33 gallon, \$2 each, sold in rolls of 5= \$10
